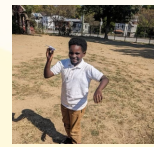
Seniors Leading the Way

Members of the Cincinnati Fire Department spoke to our MS/HS students about the history of the CFCA, summer employment, and available jobs within the city.

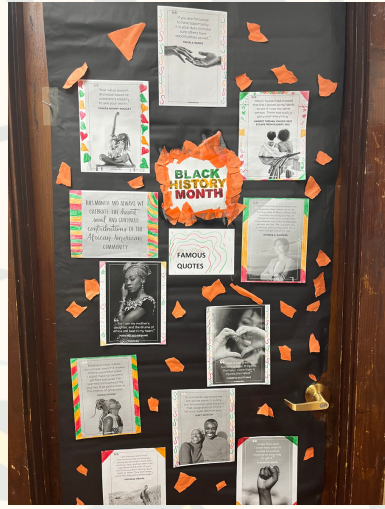


PTA Formation
